NOTICE INVITING APPLICATIONS FOR PRE-QUALIFICATION OF CONTRACTORS FOR “ARC FABRICATION WORK” IN KRIBHCO:

KRIBHCO operates Natural gas (NG) based Fertilizer Plant comprising two streams of Ammonia, four streams Urea, Power Plant, Product Handling Plant and other Offsite plants and based at Hazira, Surat, Gujarat.

Applications are invited from reputed Parties / Contractors for Prequalification / Registration for Contract for Fabrication work in KRIBHCO, Surat in Gujarat. Parties interested in pre-qualification must have work experience in relevant field at Fertilizers / Petrochemical Industries. Interested parties are requested to submit their willingness along with required documents.

Krishak Bharati Cooperative Ltd., (KRIBHCO), a fertilizer manufacturing unit located near Hazira in Surat District (Gujarat) intends to pre-qualify contractors for Fabrication Work as per following:-

DETAILED REQUIREMENTS OF PRE-QUALIFICATION CRITERIA:

The job involves Fabrication Work in KRIBHCO. The tentative scope of work is attached as Annexure-2. Interested contractors are invited to submit their application for pre-qualification considering following criteria:-

1. The contractor who have executed contracts during the last three years i.e. from June-2016 to May-2019 for “ARC for Fabrication work” for a single contract (Non-aggregated basis) having minimum value of Rs 30.00 Lakhs in a year in Fertilizer/ Petrochemical Industries. Copies of completed Service Orders executed and performance/completion certificates issued thereof for satisfactory work under the same service order from the clients only shall be considered for pre-qualification
2. The contractor should apply with relevant documents as per criteria along with **Nonrefundable fee of Rs. 590/- (Rs 500/- plus GST) per application by way of Demand Draft on nationalized or scheduled bank only drawn in favour of KRIBHCO**, payable at Surat within 30 days of this advertisement.
3. Bank Solvency Certificate by the Nationalized/Scheduled Bank issued **on or after the date of press advertisement** for a minimum value of Rs.15.0 Lakhs
4. The prospective contractors having any common partners / Directors / Managing Partners etc. or having any business / family, relations or any other common criteria shall be considers as Sister / Group / Associated Company. In such cases, only one of them will be eligible for pre-qualification. The contractors shall indicate which Associate / Concern they intend to get pre-qualified. In case no mention is made about the same, KRIBHCO at its own discretion shall decide, which shall be binding to the contractors.

NOTE:

- a) The requirements/ criteria mentioned in Annexure-1 & 2 shall supersede the criteria mentioned elsewhere.
- b) Applications received without prescribed fee and after the stipulated date will not be considered.
- c) The enlistment of Contractors shall be at the entire discretion of KRIBHCO based on objective evaluation of the details regarding past experience, technical and financial competence, and resourcefulness of the Contractors/Firms/Companies.
- d) KRIBHCO reserves the right to reject any or all the Applications without assigning any reasons thereof.
- e) KRIBHCO has the right not to issue tender form to any particular Contractor/Firm/Company and can also suspended, remove/de-list, demote or black-list the Contactor’s name under certain circumstances.
- f) All parties are requested to apply for prequalification with all the required documents in one go. Incomplete application forms are liable to be rejected.
- g) **THE APPLICANT SHALL SUBMIT APPLICATION FOR PREQUALIFICATION WITH REQUISITE DOCUMENTS BY 24.09.2019.**

The contractors shall submit Vendor Application Form (F:PUR:33) along with relevant documents considering the criteria mentioned in attached Annexure.

Annexure-II

1. ARC for Fabrication jobs

- a. The Scope of work shall be basically of Fabrication Jobs in running/shutdown Plants for various Repair & Maintenance Jobs to be executed at site by keeping skilled manpower at site of required welders/fitters/riggers/manpower/supervisors for various Job execution on round the year basis with keeping adequate tools tackles and consumables at Site.
- b. Fabrication of pipe line (CS, AS & SS) including handling, Gas cutting, edge preparation by grinding, fit-up welding & Heat Treatment as per standard Engineering Codes & Practice and finally Hydro-testing up to the required Test Pressure. Alloy Steel welding is to be done by IBR qualified Welder if required.
- c. Fabrication of Mitre Bends, Reducers, Tees including cutting, edge preparation, welding etc, as per standard Engineering Codes & Practices.
- d. Erection of Pipe Line as per supplied drawing or as per instruction of Engineer In charge, including erection of necessary pipe supports & saddles, boxing up of all flanged joints, shifting from Workshop or stores to job site & shifting of balance material from site to Workshop or stores.
- e. Dismantling of pipe line including pipe supports, as per instructions of Engineer In charge, including gas cutting, dismantling and removal of old piping, shifting the same to store/yard of workshop.
- f. Structure fabrication, including but not limited to handling, drilling gas cutting, grinding, bolting and welding of steel structure elements comprising of angles, channels, I-beams, rounds and plates of various sizes and thickness.
- g. Dismantling of structure by opening bolts, gas cutting, removing and shifting to main stores/scrap yard.
- h. Erection of steel structure as per supplied drawings or as per instructions of Engineer In-charge, including drilling, bolting and welding wherever required. Shifting of material from stores/workshop to site & shifting of balance material from site to stores/workshop.
- i. Scaffolding arrangement, cleaning of gasket faces, lapping and easing of bolts & nuts are in Contractor's Scope.
- j. Any Scaffolding arrangement required against the Item rates shall be in Contractor's Scope.
- k. To get issued material from Stores, shifting to site & return of balance material if any to Stores.
- l. The Contractor shall be responsible for final clearance of the site of work after completion of entire Maintenance work. In case of non-clearance by the Contractor.
- m. The Contractor shall deploy/maintain adequate no. of workforce for smooth running and timely completion of the job.
