

Prequalification for Contract for Critical fabrication works at Site

Category: On -Site Critical fabrication works like

- 1) Heat exchanger (operating above 100 kg/cm² pressure) re-tubing at site.
- 2) High pressure equipment's maintenance repairs like Urea Reactor lining repairs, Ammonia cracker tubes repairs.
- 3) IBR piping's, High pressure Ammonia, Synthesis gas, NG piping's above 100 kg/cm².
- 4) Capability to replace and erect heavy vessels/ equipment's and mobilise heavy duty cranes, trailers for the same.

At KRIBHCO , we are having all type of piping (½ “ NB to 24 “ NB and above) up to pressure rating of 285 kg/cm² and stationary equipment's including Heat exchangers , Vessels , towers , Columns , Tanks, Reactors , Reformers , Crackers , Boilers operating pressure rating up to 285 Kg/cm² and temperature range from minus 33 Deg C to 900 Deg C . All these equipment's are having varied range of metallurgy including Carbon steel, Alloy steel, SS, Inconel etc.

All these plants need critical mechanical maintenance during planned shutdown or breakdowns. To take care of this requirement, setup will be required at site with proper tools, tackles and manpower to fulfil requirements of the job by working during odd hrs/ shutdown.

Being a continuous process industry, quick mobilization and scheduled job completion is essential. The contractors should have their workshops / site offices with telephone facilities in western region and should be capable of mobilizing to KRIBHCO Surat site at a very short notice.

The experienced and established contractors who have enough technical expertise, necessary workshop & manpower set-ups, tools & tackles and sound financial capabilities and to whom above conditions are acceptable may only apply.

TECHNICAL CAPABILITY / PAST PERFORMANCE / EXPERIENCE

- 1) The party should submit Complete Technical Details of Services provided along with work order copies executed during last **five** years i.e. from June 2014 to May 2019 for which application is made for prequalification.
- 2) Minimum value of work orders executed should be at-least Rs 10 lakhs for single job (Non-aggregate basis).
- 3) Performance/ Completion certificate from the client for the job executed successfully.
- 4) Any other additional specific information to substantiate your credibility for the job.
- 5) List of equipment's, Tools, tackles, facilities to be enclosed
- 6) Details of engineers/ skilled personnel to be enclosed
- 7) Details of quality assurance personnel and facilities available.
- 8) Accreditation from third party agency if any to be enclosed
- 9) Details of any certifications like ISO certificates/ ASME STAMP if any and validity to be enclosed
- 10) List of work orders to be enclosed as follows along with Order Copy and technical specification sheet of order containing pressure/temperature rating and fluid handled of the equipment**
